Eric Grasham's work is informed by his study of ornamental designs across history and cultures, and how those designs idealize nature. Eric Grasham graduated from Abilene Christian University in 2011 and went to work for Bridget Hauser at Sunset Canyon Pottery for three years as a production potter as well as a teacher for beginner wheel throwing and glazing. In 2013, Grasham was awarded a position as Artist-in-Residence at the Chicken Farm Art Center in San Angelo, Texas. He spent 3 years creating wheel-thrown vessels for Roger Allen and the Starkeeper Gallery while teaching workshops and developing his own work. During his residency, Grasham gave over 600 free wheel throwing lessons during open studio days. He has taught workshops in clay piping, handbuilding, and coloring clay at the San Angelo Museum of Fine Arts, Tarrant County Community College, Wylie Art Gallery, and Rockwall Makerspace. His collaborative series with Morgan Grasham was exhibited at the San Angelo Museum of Fine Arts' Gallery Verde in 2016, and in 2018 their piece *The Stilling Engine* won Fourth Place at the San Angelo National Ceramic Competition.
